Identify and discuss education priorities...

The PEI Home and School Federation plays a central role in the Provincial Learning Partnership, which provides an opportunity for all partners in education to identify education priorities. Our Past President sits on the Learning Partners Advisory Council and the District Advisory Councils are comprised of local Home and School Presidents and the regional area representative from our Board of Directors.

Foster collaboration...

This year the Federation established a scholarship in the name of our first president, Dr. Helen MacDonald. Four home and school members attended the certificate course.

Volunteer at your local home & school...

The federation office staff are always ready to answer questions and provide guidance on a wide variety of topics so you can support your child's education.

Since passing our resolution calling for a universal provincial school lunch program in 2015, we have been participating in ongoing discussions with the Public Schools Branch, the Department of Agriculture and Fisheries, local home and school associations, the national *Coalition for Healthy School Food* and other stakeholders about the benefits and opportunities around a school lunch strategy for the province.
