#### 11:15-11:55 a.m. Round Table: Stop. Collaborate & Listen

Team effectiveness increases when teams complement each other and focus on the positives. Effective communications and trust between local Home and Schools with teachers and administrators is essential for successful projects and programs.

In this round table discussion, we are asking that you share at your tables the successes you have realized in the past year. Some of these successes may be born out of previous challenges or failures, or out of innovative and creative solutions to ongoing issues.

For the purpose of this session, we want to hear how you have learned and grown through your experiences. This session will provide an opportunity for you to share. Come prepared to share your stories and lessons learned with other Home and School members, so we can all "grow forward together"!

To assist in this process, there will be a facilitator and recorder at each round table, as well as an activity to guide your discussion.

#### 1:30-2:15 pm: Success Story Rapid Fire

To facilitate broader learning through success story sharing, our afternoon is going to include a "Rapid Fire" round. For this session, each table is going to chose one story / topic which was discussed in the morning. One person from each table will be chosen to share the selected story with the entire room. Each speaker will only have 3 minutes to speak, and after everyone has spoken, additional group questions will be answered.

There are two goals for this session. First, the PEIHSF wants to strengthen each local by sharing stories/experiences, as this allows the lessons to spread. Second, the PEIHSF wants to know how members advocated and communicated within the local. This focus will help strengthen other locals in their work, and will also enhance the Federation in its mandate to better advocate and communicate to, and for, the locals.
